Drinking water meters: Don't install meters

Let us know why: I am not convinced that we are losing 50% of our water through leaking pipes - surely there is a cheaper way to identify leaks? - even with wrap-around flow meters.

Let us know why: We need to support those people who have worked their lives in our community and do not own their own house - some of these people have worked their lives in the rural district with a dwelling supplied as part of their salary package. We will not be able to support all but will need a means test.

What do you think about our plans for our other projects and activities?: While stock water closure is sensible it seems also sensible to utilize some of this consented water for MAR - managed aquifer recharge -to help sustain our rural community which is critical to our towns survival. There seems little or no investment in the 10yr plan for sport and recreation - providing new and up to date opportunities for our young people to be active is critical to their well being - we spend too much time with the 'ambulance at the bottom of the cliff' rather keeping our community active and healthy at the top of the cliff. Is spending money on biodiversity a role for the District council or Regional - I prefer only one being the Regional who has been working in that space already Do we need to consider sub surface application of our effluent yet? We have already set the standard for waste management and are still waiting for the larger cities to catch up - do we need to make another leap yet or should we consolidate and evaluate new options as they develop in future years?
